

Information on the conditions of purchase and use of the works.

By participating in the **DONA UN'OPERA (DONATE AN ARTWORK)** fundraising promoted by the Association of Production Designers, Costume Designers and Set Decorators based in Rome, via Tuscolana 1055, VAT number 04121331005 (hereinafter also **ASC**)

The bidder declares to be aware that the sale of the artwork is governed by article 1336 of the Italian Civil Code and that therefore the price indicated on the catalogue published on the site is an "offer to the public" subject to upward bidding until the closing date of May 3rd, 2020.

THE FUNDRAISING will begin on April 16th, 2020 and **will end on May 3rd, 2020.**

To be aware that, on May 3rd, 2020, ASC will publish the initials of the final purchaser of the artwork on the website www.aesseci.org. By participating, the bidder expressly undertakes to pay the final purchase price of the artwork when ASC confirms, by email, the ASSIGNMENT OF THE CHOSEN ARTWORK at the end of the public auction and after the confirmation of award by the ASC.

For the foregoing, the bidder acknowledges that the offer is binding at the time when it will be accepted by ASC via e-mail and/or CEM, and that, for the effect, it will be expressly obliged to purchase the artwork within 3 days from receiving news that the offer is accepted. By participating in the initiative, the bidder expressly declares to be aware that the purchase of the artwork does not include the assignment of economic and moral exploitation rights of the same, and, therefore, may make personal and private use of it (purely by way of example and not exhaustive, whereas the right to exhibit the work in public, to reproduce it by any means and in any way, including via the Internet, the right to film it for documentary purposes, films or photographs intended for public and non-private use, as well as any other right of economic exploitation of the work, remain in the author's ownership as expressly recognized to authors by Law 633/1941).

Due to the COVID-19 emergency, and for the entire time period in which further government restrictions will be implemented regarding those in force from April 15th, 2020, the shipments may be delayed and, therefore, the Italian Association of Production Designers, Costume Designers and Set Decorators does not have the possibility to ensure compliance with the shipping and delivery deadlines specified on the Site and on the Regulations.

In any case, ASC expressly undertakes to communicate by email the date and the shipping methods of the artwork, by sending the buyer the tracking code.
