

## **PROCEDURES FOR PARTICIPATING IN THE ASC FUNDRAISING DONA UN'OPERA (DONATE AN ARTWORK)**

In the past few days, the ASC (Italian Association of Production Designers, Costume Designers and Set Decorators) has organized a fundraising benefit through the sale of the artwork donated to the Association for free.

**The offers received will be entirely donated by ASC to the non-profit association BINARIO 95, for the Covid-19 emergency**, with the only deduction of the amount necessary for the shipping costs of the artwork.

**The sale will take place through the publication of the catalogue containing the aforementioned artworks on the website [www.aesseci.org](http://www.aesseci.org)**

### **1 - RESERVING THE ARTWORK**

Within the catalogue, each donor's work will be protected by a watermark with the ASC logos (to avoid reproduction) and will be identified with a number, the minimum bid offer and a description of the technical details.

**Reservations will close on May 3<sup>rd</sup> 2020.**

### **2 - UPDATE OF THE RECEIVED OFFERS**

**The upward offers received will be updated daily on our website [www.aesseci.org](http://www.aesseci.org)** with indication of the highest proposal received and only the initials of the bidder, in respect of privacy.

Each offering buyer will then be able to monitor the progress of the offers for the interested artwork and potentially raise.

We would not like the sale of our works to be considered as an "auction" but rather as a "**solidarity race**" to try to reach the highest possible figure.

**On MAY 4<sup>th</sup>, 2020 (day after the closing of the offers), the association will publish on its website the initials of who has made the highest offer and will therefore have been awarded the work.**

### 3- ASSIGNMENT AND RELATED CONFIRMATION BANK TRANSFER

**On May 4<sup>th</sup>, 2020 ASC will send the best bidders an email with all the information to complete the purchase of the work.** Pursuant to and for the purposes of Article 1336 of the Italian Civil Code, the final offer that will be published by ASC on May 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2020 **is binding and obliges the bidder to purchase the work.**

The buyer who will receive confirmation of the assignment of the artwork - having proposed the best offer - will undertake to make the transfer with the amount offered, at the following bank details:

Shipments will be made via registered and traceable mail.

We will inform you of the confirmed shipment.

ASC undertakes to carry out the shipments within the term of 15 days starting from the crediting of the amounts; however, shipments may be subject to organizational delays not dependent on our will, due to the on-going COVID-19 emergency. In case of delays, we will inform you about the delivery times.

### 5- TERMS AND CONDITIONS

The ASC, in compliance with current legislation on the protection of personal data, Legislative Decree 196/2003 as integrated by the GDPR 679/2016, undertakes not to disclose, publish and divulge your personal data to third parties, and to use them only to communicate its initiatives.

ASC will communicate and divulge the final result of the collection on the website [www.aesseci.org](http://www.aesseci.org) and on the association's related social profiles to announce the final amount collected in total transparency, ensuring that your identity will remain anonymous.
